How Fiber Business Internet is Helping Businesses Recover in 2021

It is a new year. It is time to shake off 2020 and look forward to the business recovery that is already underway. The global economy is expected to rebound in 2021, although it may be a little stop-and-go until a vaccine is widely available.

If we learned anything last year, it was about the need to be flexible and agile. That means overcoming any challenges before us and moving rapidly when opportunities arise. To do that, you are going to need a robust infrastructure built on a solid foundation of fiber business internet service.

Here is why using a fiber business internet provider is the best solution and how LOGIX can help your business recover from 2020 more quickly.

Speed

When you are in the middle of a recovery, you need lightning-fast internet that can move as fast as your business. You cannot afford slow internet.

Fiber business internet needs to include synchronous speeds so that you have the same fast uploads and download speeds. This is important when moving files back and forth to the cloud, connecting multiple buildings, or providing data for employees working at home. While many cable, national and residential internet providers limit upload speeds, fiber business internet from LOGIX Fiber Networks gives you synchronous speeds so you are not waiting for files to upload.

The difference can be significant. For example, if you have a 1-Gbps fiber internet connection with synchronous speeds, you can download a 1-GB file in 9 seconds. If you are working with a provider that caps their upload speeds at the industry average of 25 Mbps, that same file can take nearly five and a half minutes. That is time your employees are not being productive, and potentially slowing down the internet for everyone else in the office.

LOGIX provides lightning-fast business internet speeds up to 10 Gbps (and faster) as well as synchronous speeds.



Reliability

The <u>best business internet</u> provider is one that is reliable. Your business depends on being connected to serve your employees and customers. That works out to be roughly 5 minutes and 15 seconds of downtime in an entire year — less time than it takes to upload that 1-GB file with limited upload speeds.
