

## DNS Records Needed for LOGIX-Hosted Microsoft Exchange

### *Who needs this User Guide?*

Customers who have their Domain Name Service hosted by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party.

### *Why this User Guide?*

This guide will provide the Host records needed to point your domain's E-mail traffic to LOGIX-Hosted Microsoft Exchange. Please contact your DNS provider if you have configuration questions.

#### Records for all customers:

| Type | Hostname            | TTL  | IP              |

| A    | mail.yourdomain.com | 3600 | 139.138.158.102 |
| A    | smtp.yourdomain.com | 3600 | 139.138.158.101 |

| Type | Hostname                          | TTL  | Port | Target              |

| SRV  | _autodiscover._tcp.yourdomain.com | 3600 | 443  | mail.logixcloud.com |

\*Recommended SRV record weight and priority is 0
